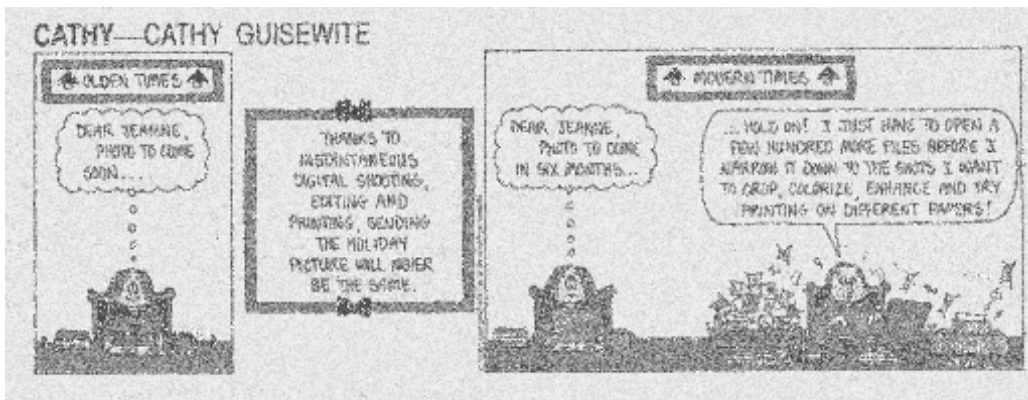
Jan 17th Program
